THREE WAYS TO LEARN!

We now provide a combination of classroom and On-The-Water (OTW) training programs designed to teach you the basics of boating safety on the water. You will learn and practice docking boat handling underway and much more.

1 For US Power Squadron members who have completed the ABC boating class and desire some basic boat maneuvering skills, we now offer the **USPS Jump Start** program. This is a 2 hour boating orientation session aimed at the new boater who needs introductory training on docking, slow speed maneuvering, and general safe boat handling.

2 **ABC Course On-the-Water** For US Power Squadron members who have completed ABC class and have some boating experience, we now offer an **ABC On-the-Water Training** session. This training is more in depth than the Jump Start 2 hour orientation and is designed for boat owners who don't need the basic Jump Start program but who would like some **On-The-Water Training** following their ABC course. The course covers boat maneuvering, Rules of the Road, Anchoring, local waters navigation, emergencies and much more. There is no additional charge for this OTW training and it is open to all ABC class graduates.

3 For US Power Squadron members who have completed USPS Seamanship class we now offer a more extensive On-the-Water training session. Seamanship graduates and sign up for the **Seamanship On-The-Water** training and we will provide hands-on training on the skills you learned in Seamanship on you in your own boat. This training is designed for boat owners who would like more in depth training on departing and arriving at a dock, emergencies, Navigation, anchoring, local waters knowledge, and more following the Seamanship course. There is no additional charge for this OTW training and it is open to all Seamanship class graduates.
